The new clinic will feature a comprehensive range of services including orthopedic consultations, rheumatology care, sports medicine evaluations, pain management care, and an acute walk-in clinic. By offering walk-in and specialty services in one location, OSMS makes it easier for patients to receive timely care for urgent orthopedic needs such as fractures, sprains, cuts, sports injuries, and work-related injuries helping patients avoid emergency room costs.

The clinic will feature 20 patient exam rooms, the latest X-ray and MRI technology, an on-site lab, along with infusion suites for treating rheumatic disease and other conditions. The facility will also be equipped to handle procedures like carpal tunnel release that can be formed under local anesthesia and will also offer physical and occupational therapy.

"Our focus has always been on delivering the right care, at the right time, in the most accessible way possible," said Dr. Bryan Royce, orthopedic surgeon and physician owner at OSMS. "This new clinic gives us the space to provide more personalized treatment options and work closely with patients to help them get back to doing the things they love."

"We're building this clinic for the people who need us most. When patients utilize our acute walk-in clinic, it is the same cost as if they had an appointment, and our specialized focus means they're getting the care they deserve," said Dr. Luke Fraundorf, orthopedic surgeon and physician owner at OSMS. "By creating a dedicated space in Oshkosh, we're making it easier for patients to access the services they need close to home."
