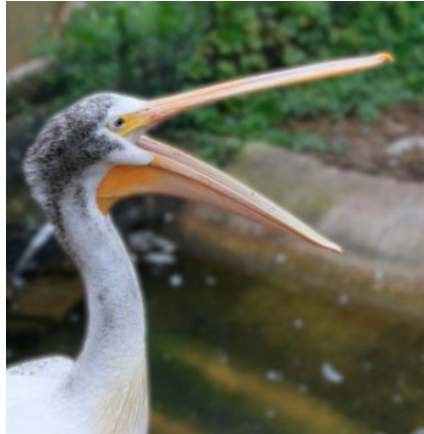

Go WILD this Summer with New and Returning Experiences



The NEW Zoo & Adventure Park is happy to announce that summer is officially starting at the Zoo this weekend! As of this Saturday, May 24th, the popular and highly requested **Penguin and Pelican Feeding Experiences** are back daily, along with two new-for-summer behind-the-scenes experiences: **Snow Leopard Den Tours** and **Aldabra Tortoise VIP Experiences**. A variety of other free, educational, and hands-on **Discovery Stations** will also be available throughout the day according to the following schedule: 9:00 a.m. - African Penguin Station; 10:30 a.m. - Whooping Crane Station; 12:30 p.m. - Bald Eagle Station; and 2:00 p.m. - Big Cats Station.

Tickets for feeding the penguins, pelicans, and going behind-the-scenes at the Snow Leopard and Aldabra Tortoise habitats are limited, so we strongly encourage guests to purchase those in advance online at newzoo.org. A variety of other private **Wild Encounter** programs that provide up-close encounters with several of the zoo's residents are also available for sale online for the summer months. The **Giraffe Feeding Experience** remains open daily from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and again from 2:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. this time of year. The **Children's Zoo Feeding Experience** will also be open most days from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for the summer season, and the zoo's **Endangered Species Carousel** will operate most days from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. There are times when experiences may close early or stay open a little later, depending on weather and attendance.
