The Greater Green Bay Teen Leadership Program's mission is to build and strengthen emerging young leaders with skills, knowledge, and experiences that prepare them to be effective partners for positive change in the Greater Green Bay area.

Each year about 40 to 50 sophomore students from over 15 area schools are accepted into the program. Student participants will experience many different aspects of Green Bay, and have the opportunity of speaking to elected officials, business CEO's, non-profit managers, members of law enforcement, and many more community leaders to hear some of the many leadership stories. Also, students will work in small groups to research, develop, and implement a community project.

*The Program Curriculum:*

Greater Green Bay Teen Leadership is a program based on the Student Leadership Challenge book that was handed out to the students at the beginning of our sessions. This book stresses the importance of the five practices of exemplary leadership: **Model the Way, Inspire a Shared Vision, Challenge the Process, Enable Others to Act, and Encourage the Heart.**
