

Sail into some great prizes with Green Bay's First Ship Contest

Now's the time to enter your guess to win

(Green Bay, Wis.) – When it comes to shipping on the Great Lakes and St. Lawrence Seaway System there's not much of an off season. The final ship to reach the [Port of Green Bay](#) for the 2020 shipping season was the Michigan Great Lakes, which delivered petroleum products to U.S. Oil on Jan. 19. Now, it's time to launch the First Ship Contest, sponsored by the Port and the [Greater Green Bay Convention & Visitors Bureau \(CVB\)](#) for the 2021 shipping season.

The Port and CVB are encouraging area residents to submit their guesses for what date and time they believe the 2021 shipping season will begin, which is officially marked by the arrival of the first vessel in Port. The winning entry will be the person whose guess comes closest to the date and time of the arrival of the first ship. The prize package for the First Ship Contest includes a \$100 Door County gift certificate (good at a variety of shops, attractions and lodging) and two Port of Green Bay drawstring goodie bags.

"The opening of the shipping season is dependent on a number of factors, including the weather and when it's warm enough to melt the ice throughout the St. Lawrence Seaway," explained Dean Haen, Port Director. "Water conditions in other parts of the Great Lakes play a part as well. So, year to year, the opening can vary by as much as 30 days."

The range of dates for the first ship arriving in Port has been March 15 to April 5 over the past five years:

- 2020: March 15
- 2019: April 5
- 2018: March 26
- 2017: March 21
- 2016: March 21
