Spring Break Camp at the NEW Zoo



This March, the NEW Zoo & Adventure Park is offering a fun day of learning & play – it's the perfect way to keep kids busy during Spring Break! These **day-camp, drop-off programs** are designed for **students in 1st through 4th grades**, and each child can attend up to one date. A morning snack is provided by the zoo, but parents must provide a non-microwaveable, non-refrigerated lunch for each child. Each day's program includes educational presentations, live animal encounters, zoo tours, and other fun activities like games and crafts. Children should dress for the weather and wear comfortable shoes. Face coverings are required, and our learning spaces will be set to allow for social distancing.

This year's Spring Break Camp theme is "**Growing Up Wild.**" Every animal species has its own unique life cycle, with its own special stages of development. We'll explore how the spring season brings many changes for critters around the world – from bugs to birds, we'll take a close-up look at the interesting ways animals grow and change.
