## Summer Camp Registration Starts March 26<sup>th</sup>



We're pleased to release the 2021 topics and schedule for the NEW Zoo & Adventure Park's **Summer Zoo Camp Programs** for elementary school-aged children. Registration opens March 26<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.

**This year, the Zoo is offering TWO types of summer camp programs:**

- Single-day "Summer Safari" programs for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> graders, where students may attend **up to two different dates** with different topics at a cost of \$40 per day (Zoo Pass Members receive a 20% discount)

And

- Two-day "Summer Zoo Camp" programs for 5<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> graders, where students must attend **two consecutive dates** with the same topic at a cost of \$90 per two-day session (Zoo Pass Members receive a 20% discount)

**All programs will begin at 8:45am and end at 3:00pm daily.** Children must be registered to attend a day that corresponds to their age group and the **grade they will be entering in fall of 2021**. A morning snack and afternoon treat is provided by the zoo, but parents must provide a non-microwaveable, non-refrigerated lunch for each camper. Each day's program includes educational presentations, live animal encounters, zoo tours, and other fun activities like games and crafts. Children should dress for the weather and wear comfortable shoes. Face coverings are required for indoor activities and the zoo can and will provide disposable masks as needed. Capacity is limited, and safe, social distancing guidelines as recommended by the CDC and American Camp Association will be followed.
